

Crop Disaster Program For Alfalfa William T. W. Woodward¹

On March 11, 2005 Agriculture Secretary Mike Johanns announced that eligible producers may sign-up for the Crop Disaster Program (CDP) beginning March 14 at their local USDA Service Center. The CDP authorizes crop loss assistance for producers who suffered 2003 or 2004 and certain 2005 crop losses from damaging weather. Recently the Franklin County FSA Office in Pasco held some informational meetings to help producers prepare for application for the Crop Disaster Program.
